### **What is your organisational name and legal structure?**

Jack Halliday and Rhonda Small authorise all the material on our website. We are not standing candidates in the election. And we are not endorsing any political parties.

### **What is your anticipated budget for the election activities?**

Progressive Port Phillip is not standing candidates in the election. Proposed activities relate to encouraging people to vote and think about the issues. Our ability to undertake that work will depend on our capacity to fundraise with our supporters.

### **How will the money be raised?**

Progressive Port Phillip is being funded from donations by individual members of the Port Phillip community. One cornerstone donation has been made by the Lofgren Family Bequest. Under no circumstances will we be taking donations from political parties, property developers housing associations; the fossil fuel or arms industries, gambling or tobacco.

**Who are your top ten donors?** We are in the process of fundraising and welcome contributions from people living or working in Port Phillip. We intend to release the names of our top 10 donors, with their approval, well before the Election Date.

**Will you be running or endorsing candidates?**

No. Progressive Port Phillip is non-partisan and will not stand candidates in the council election, nor endorse political parties. We will promote progressive policies to all candidates and to the community, raise awareness of issues and analysis and call out myths and misinformation.
